The Rolling Stones are an English rock band formed in London in 1962. The actual members of the band are Mick Jagger, lead and backing vocals, harmonica, piano, guitar; Keith Richards, guitar, backing and lead vocals, bass guitar; Charlie Watts, drums, percussion; Ronnie Wood, guitar, lap steel guitar, pedal steel guitar, slide guitar, backing vocals, bass guitar.

The Rolling Stones were inducted into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame in 1989, and into the UK Music Hall of Fame in 2004. *ROLLING STONE* magazine ranked them fourth on the "100 Greatest Artists of All Time" list, and their estimated sales are above 200 million. They have released twenty-nine studio albums, eighteen live albums and numerous compilations. The Rolling Stones celebrated their 50th anniversary in the summer of 2012 by releasing a large hardback book titled 50.
