MUCH / MANY

"Much" e "Many" significam "muito" em inglês e possuem regras específicas de uso.

- Nós usamos MUCH com substantivos incontáveis, que não podemos contar. (*Ex.: music, art, love, happiness, advice, information, news*).
- Usamos o MANY com substantivos contáveis, que podemos contar. São aquelas palavras que possuem a forma singular e plural (*Ex.: dog, cat, animal, man, person, bottle, box, litre*). Essas palavras são usadas sempre no plural quando antecedidas por "many".

Exemplos:

- I have many books. (Eu tenho muitos livros.)
- I have many cats. (Eu tenho muitos gatos.)
- She has many kids at home right now. (Ela tem muitas crianças em casa agora.)
- There are many schools near my house. (Há muitas escolas perto da minha casa.)
- I don't have much time. (Eu não tenho muito tempo.)
- They didn't use much flour to make the cake. (Eles não usaram muita farinha para fazer o bolo.)
- You drink much juice. (Você bebe muito suco.)
- He has much money. (Ele tem muito dinheiro.)
