## HOW TO IDENTIFY IF THE NEWS YOU ARE READING IS FAKE OR REAL?

Nowadays, people are facing many problems regarding fake news. Many things that we share on social media can be false. There are many hints given by specialists to help you detect if a piece of news is fake or real and this exercise is very important in order not to spread lies:

- 1. Check the website where you are reading it. Normally, fake news comes from unfamiliar websites.
- 2. Double check the URL. If it doesn't match the news outlet, it can be a sign that it is not real.
- 3. When you read an article and notice that the headline doesn't match the topic of the text, it is probably fake.
- 4. When there are many problems of spelling or grammar, it shows that no review was made. So, be careful and check the source of it.
- 5. The date of the news can help you a lot. Check if it is a current one.
